



## Reception Homework Autumn Term 2

Work should be recorded in the homework book using pictures, photos or children's writing. When recording their work in writing children should sound out their own words using their phonetic knowledge, and remembering their red words. We do not expect every word to be spelt conventionally!

1. Children are required to complete the following project in order to earn them a merit mark.
2. Remember to read at least **four times per week** and ask an adult to write in your homework diary to earn 2 stampers per week.
3. Remember to complete **IXL tasks** that are set weekly.
4. The due date for all projects is **Monday 11<sup>th</sup> December**.

### Autumn 2 Homework Project – People Who Help Us

Identify and choose one person that helps you (eg Nurse, Firefighter, Police Officer, Vet or Doctor).  
Use the computer to research your chosen emergency service.

Describe what they do and how they help you. An adult should record your conversation writing the words you say.

Either:

Draw your own picture of them in your book including the place they work and the vehicle they drive. Label their specialist equipment, uniform, place of work and vehicle. Remember to sound out the words with an adult and record what you hear.

or

Create a model of your chosen emergency service vehicle (eg fire engine, ambulance or police car). You could use junk materials such as boxes, construction toys such as lego or playdough / clay. Take a photo of your model for your book.
